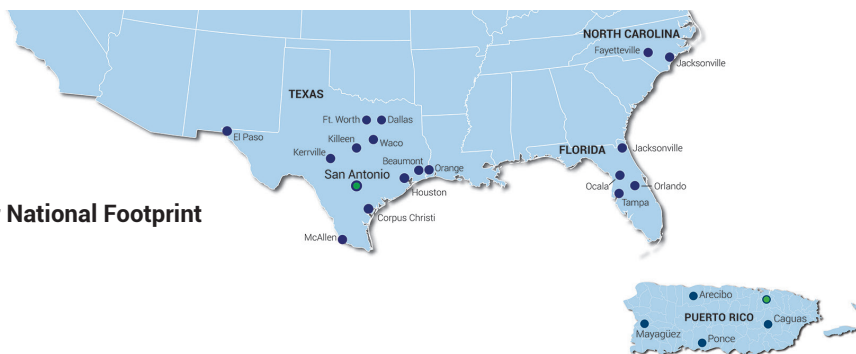


Capability Statement

CORE COMPETENCIES

Family Endeavors, Inc. dba Endeavors[®] is a provider of services in support of children, families, Veterans, and those struggling with mental illness. The Mission of Endeavors is to passionately serve vulnerable people in crisis through our innovative, personalized approach. The Vision of Endeavors is to restore dignity and improve the quality of life for the vulnerable people we serve through the benefits of our programs. To do so, Endeavors offers:

- **Veteran and Military Family Services.** We support veterans and their military families by providing programs that focus on everything from parenting skills to mental health care to homelessness prevention and stabilization.
- **Mental Health Services.** In order to provide high-quality, accessible, and integrated mental health care to all veterans and their families, our services are available regardless of role, discharge status, or ability to pay. Endeavors provides mental health services to Veterans, active duty military, and their family members through our Military Family Clinics (MFCs). Our MFCs in San Antonio, El Paso, and Killeen provides in house and tele-health mental services, psychiatric services, as well as life skill courses at no to low cost.
- **Community Services.** Our community partnerships focus on families, seniors, children, and individuals who require case management, clinical services, and life-skills training. These classes include, financial literacy, parenting, employment, and marriage and relationship strengthening.
- **Housing Services.** We connect veteran families and those with disabilities to supportive housing, case management, professional counseling, life skills training, and employment opportunities.
- **Supportive Employment.** Our staffing services respond to emergent situations and healthcare setting needs by providing supportive employment opportunities to individuals with disabilities.
- **Disaster Relief.** We develop recovery plans, create safe environments, and provide resource referrals for anyone impacted by Presidentially Declared Disasters. Endeavors has the capacity and capability to deploy large amounts of staff in a short amount of time. In response to Presidentially Declared Disasters and emergency sheltering taskings.
